

## Spills Kit Contents

- Container for detergent mix plus detergent
- Rubber gloves
- Face and eye protection
- Plastic apron
- Paper towels (high absorbency)
- Scrapers ( 2 sheets of cardboard)
- Biohazard bag and hazard sign
- Absorbent material for soaking up spill (granules)

Method for cleaning spills:

- Don gloves, mask, apron and eye shield
- Wipe up any solid or excess material

If the spill is on a hard surface:

- Clean with detergent mixture (Clinidet or Sonidet).
- Dry the surface and dispose of paper products.
- Clean any mop or bucket used.

If the spill is on carpet or fabric:

- Do not use a liquid as this will spread the spill.
- Apply absorbent material (granules) to contain the spill, scrape up residue, dispose of in your contaminated waste bin.
- Clean carpet with detergent and water (or carpet cleaning product).
- Quarantine the area until the carpet is dry.

A disinfectant (eg.Viraclean) may be used on a hard surface only if required and left on according to the manufacturer's instructions, then wiped off.
